

## **IN FOUR STEPS**

## **GETTING STARTED WITH CATEFIX**



### STEP 1

Shake the can Catefix well before use. Then pour Catefix directly from the packaging into your low-pressure syringe.



#### STEP 2

**Spray a ring around the nest with an overlap of about 5 cms** and spray Catefix on the outside of the nest until all caterpillars and spins are covered with Catefix.

#### **STEP 3**



Then **inject Catefix well into the nest.** This is done by holding the end of your syringe at the top of the nest so that all caterpillars are soaked with Catefix. The caterpillars will then move and get stuck together with their stinging hairs. Then spray over the nest and inject into the nest at the halfway point of the nest. During this treatment you will see that Catefix (still in liquid form) seeps through the nest.

This is the intention as a nest is not watertight. The consumption is the same as the contents of the nest. So for a 0.5 litre nest you also need 0.5 litres of Catefix.

#### STEP 4



**Wait 1-2 minutes** and see if you have actually put all the caterpillars in good contact with Catefix. If this is not the case, treat the nest again.

From this point on you don't have to do anything! Catefix dries in a few hours and forms a "glass" hard connection in and around the nest.



Catefix must be applied and deployed on a nest (i.e. with a web). No web is no nest.
